Introduction:

The demand of governments and companies for cyber solutions, to protect infrastructures from the dangers of these attacks, a recent study predicted the growth of the cybersecurity sector at large rates in the coming years, with the increase in the need for cybersecurity, which is likely to witness tremendous growth, a study conducted by Global Market Insights estimated that the value of the cybersecurity sector will double to \$300 billion by 2024, and that the pace of competition among companies operating in the sector will intensify, especially in the Middle East and North Africa, and expectations indicate an increase in the value of the cybersecurity market in the Middle East and North Africa. Africa to reach \$2.89 billion by 2026, with an annual growth rate of 7.92% over the period from 2021 to 2026.

مع تسارع وتيرة التحول الرقمي، والارتفاع الكبير في الهجمات الإلكترونية، والذي زاد من طلب الحكومات والشركات على الحلول السيبرانية، لحماية البنى التحتية من مخاطر تلك الهجمات، فقد توقعت دراسة حديثة نمو قطاع الأمن السيبراني بمعدلات كبيرة خلال السنوات المقبلة، مع زيادة الحاجة إلى الأمن السيبراني الذي من المرجح أن يشهد نموا هائلا، ورجحت دراسة أجرتها Global Market Insights ، أن تتضاعف قيمة قطاع الأمن السيبراني إلى ٣٠٠ مليار دولار بحلول عام ٢٠٢٤، وأن تتقدم وتيرة المنافسة بين الشركات العاملة في القطاع، خصوصا بمنطقة الشرق الأوسط وشمال إفريقيا، وتشير التوقعات إلى ارتفاع قيمة سوق الأمن السيبراني في الشرق الأوسط وشمال إفريقيا إلى ٢,٨٩ مليار دولار أمريكي بحلول عام ٢٠٢٦م، بمعدل نمو سنوي نسبته ٧,٩٢٪ خلال المدة من ٢٠٢١ إلى ٢٠٢٦.

مما يوضح أهمية تناول هذه الموضوعات ومتابعة تطوراتها العالمية لدعم وحماية محتوى الفضاء السحابي لدولة الكويت ودول مجلس التعاون لمواجهة الهجمات السيبرانية التي تستهدف البنية التحتية للدول وضرورة توحيد الجهود الخليجية لمواجهة تحديات الأمن السيبراني وتوفير الحماية اللازمة للبيانات والمعلومات الحساسة الخاصة بدول مجلس التعاون الخليجي عبر وضع استراتيجيات وطنية لمواجهة تلك التحديات.

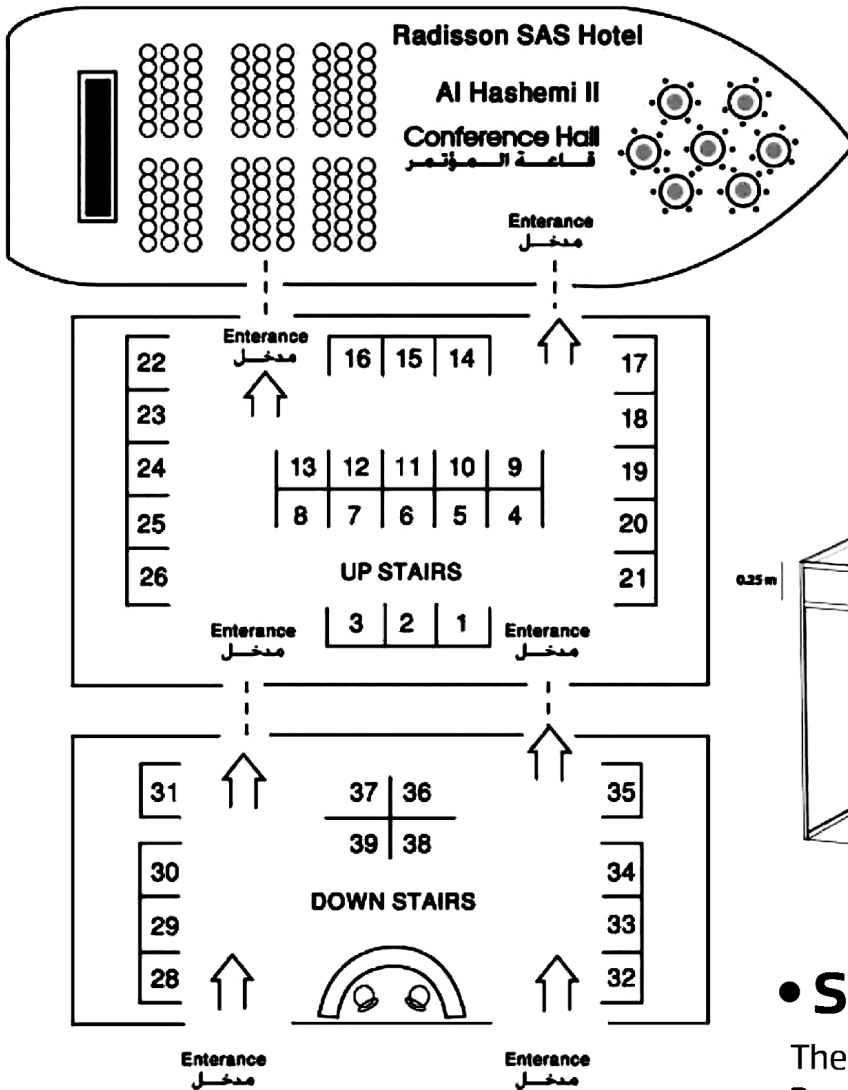
